Conditions of Entry

Competitors must cut and steep in the Devon style the following distances

Open 10 yards

Intermediate 8 yards

Novices 6 yards

The site will be open from 08.30. On arrival competitors must register to draw their length number on a "first come first served basis". The competition will start at 09.30 prompt, no allowance will be made for latecomers. Veterans (over 60) may enter either the open or intermediate class.

Only natural crooks may be used. Some crooks may be available on the day but competitors are <u>strongly advised to bring their own</u>. No chainsaws are to be used. Chainsaw operators will be available for each class. Cutting money will be paid to non prize winners completing their lengths.

Each competitor to steep the length drawn starting from their number and working towards the next highest number. Each competitor to lay off the first few steepers for the next competitor to use. A **short ladder** may be useful on the bank.

Judging will be on a points basis.

50 points max. Quality of cutting, finish of cut stool, lack of splitting.

20 points max. Selection and best use of crooks leading to overall

strength of finished hedge.

30 points max. General appearance and quality-neatness of finished

hedge/brash pile and effectiveness as a stock-proof barrier.
